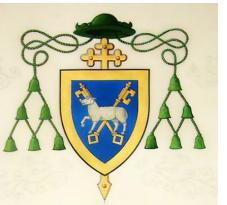

RE-OPENING OF CHURCHES AS PLACES OF PRAYER

The Northern Ireland Executives announced recently that churches could be re-opened as of Wednesday 20th May. The six parish churches within our pastoral community have now re-opened and are accessible for private prayer.

Those who visit to pray will be expected to observe social distancing whilst in the church, in addition to following the directions of the stewards
