

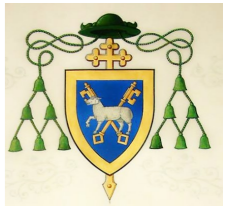

PREPARING FOR THE PUBLIC CELEBRATION OF MASS

As of June 29th, the Northern Ireland Executive has granted permission for the resumption of the celebration of public worship in churches. This follows on from the recent re-opening of churches for the purpose of personal/solitary prayer. In response, Bishop Treanor has formulated guidelines to parish priests, to assist in the process of preparing for public worship. The health and safety of parishioners is paramount. At present, parishes across the diocese are preparing for the resumption of public Mass; in this regard, the Bishop has also emphasised that churches should welcome parishioners to Mass, only when it is safe to do so, hence the importance of all the preparations. As such, each parish will naturally follow a unique timeline. The priests of the pastoral community have formulated a provisional timetable focussing on weekday Masses, and will also in stage two, focus on a timetable for weekend Masses. Details of the timetable will be conveyed in the coming days. It is important that parishes proceed in a safe and balanced manner, taking 'small steps' in a paced manner. At this stage, it must be understood, that an immediate restoration of the pre-existing Mass timetable in all parishes would not be a sensible pathway to pursue. We will all have to exercise patience throughout the gradual process. More details soon.

GOVERNMENT GUIDELINES IN RELATION TO PARISHES

The Northern Ireland Executive Office on Tuesday last(30th June,) decreed the following:

Funerals:

The Maximum number that can attend a funeral service will be determined by the size and circumstances of the venue, whilst facilitating social distancing and observing safety guidelines. Therefore, the number attending funeral rites in the church may be permitted up to the capacity of the church determined when the risk assessment was carried out for the re-commencement of Mass and Sacraments. The Diocese of Down & Connor will maintain the two metre social-distancing guideline for the present. The Executive guidance indicates that the maximum number who may attend the committal at the graveside or doors of the crematorium is capped to 30 persons.

Weddings:

As previously advised, the numbers attending **outdoor weddings** is capped at 30 persons. For **indoor weddings** (permitted only where one of the parties has a terminal illness) the number attending has been increased from 10 to 30 persons.

Baptisms: Parishes are still awaiting permission to arrange baptisms. These changes have immediate effect.
